

2026 Outstanding Educator Award

PURPOSE	To provide recognition and encouragement for university teaching faculty members in construction education.
CANDIDATES	Must be a full-time, teaching faculty member of a university construction program or a construction-related engineering program or with an institution-approved con- struction option. Non-teaching administrators, such as department heads, program coordinators, and higher positions will not be considered for this award. Nominees must have <u>at least</u> four (4) years full-time teaching experience. Program must be accredited by either the American Council for Construction Education (ACCE) or the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET).
NOMINATION LETTER	Must be submitted jointly (in one letter) - signed by an administrative faculty member of the nominee's institution and an officer of a construction firm whose company is an AGC member.
CRITERIA FOR EVALUATION	 Nominees will be judged by three criteria: (a) Full-time undergraduate teaching responsibilities (45%); (b) Extracurricular activities with undergraduate and graduate students (30%); and (c) Activities with AGC chapters, national AGC, and/or other construction industry organizations (25%).
AWARD	The Outstanding Educator Award will be in the amount of \$10,000 (\$5,000 cash and two \$2,500 scholarship awards to give to two students of your choice), plus an all-expense paid trip to the <u>2026 AGC Annual Convention</u> , where the award will be presented. (Expenses are paid for the winning Educator <u>only</u> .)

Competition Rules and Regulations 2026 Outstanding Educator Award

1. Purpose

The purpose of the Outstanding Educator Award is to provide recognition and encouragement for university teaching faculty members in construction education.

2. Eligibility

A nominee must be a **full-time teaching faculty** member of a four-year university construction program or a construction-related engineering program with an institution-approved construction option. Program must be accredited either by ACCE (American Council for Construction Education) or ABET (Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology). **Nominees must have** <u>at least</u> four (4) years full-time teaching experience.

Non-teaching administrators, such as department heads, program coordinators and higher positions, will not be considered for this award.

3. Nominations

- A. This nomination form must be accompanied by one letter of nomination; signed jointly by an administrative faculty member of the nominee's institution and an officer of a construction firm whose company is an AGC member.
- B. The nominee is responsible for ensuring that all items listed below are submitted via email in one package directly to the AGC Foundation and <u>no later than NOVEMBER 15.</u>
 <u>2025</u>. You will receive confirmation of receipt by email.
 - (a) nomination checklist;
 - (b) joint letter of nomination (see Section 3A of rules, above);
 - (c) completed application form with attachments;
 - (d) undergraduate teaching load summary sheet (see Section III D);
 - (e) statement from administrator of nominee's department as to what constitutes a full-time teaching load at that institution (see Section III E);
 - (f) evidence of ACCE or ABET accreditation (see Section II C); and
 - (g) a maximum of three (3) letters of reference (see Section VIII).

4. Evaluation

- A. Nominees will be judged on three criteria:
 - (a) full-time undergraduate teaching responsibilities(45%);
 - (b) extracurricular activities with undergraduate and graduate students (30%); and

(c) activities with AGC chapters, national AGC and/or other construction industry organizations (25%).

B. Nominations will be reviewed and the recipient selected by the Board of Directors of the AGC Education and Research Foundation at its Annual Meeting in January 2026.

5. Awards

- A. The winner of the Outstanding Educator Award will be notified by mail in January/February 2024 prior to the Annual Convention of the Associated General Contractors of America. Only one winner will be selected. The AGC Education and Research Foundation Board of Directors reserve the right not to select a winner of this award in years when qualified candidates are not nominated.
- B. The Outstanding Educator Award will be in the amount of **\$10,000** (\$5,000 in cash and two \$2,500 scholarships awarded to two students of your choice), plus a trip to the 2024 Annual Convention, where the award will be presented. No cash substitution will be provided if the educator chooses not to participate in the Convention trip.
- C. The Convention trip will include round-trip coach airfare plus meals and lodging for up to four (4) days. **Spouse/children travel expenses to the AGC Convention are the responsibility of the winning educator.**
